# Leave Your Message After the Tone...

A distant cousin of mine passed away on Monday, March 8th. Our grandfathers were brothers. I had never met Greg, but I had talked, emailed, and texted with him so much for the past 12 months, I felt like I knew him. He was a wealth of information in relation to our family history. He grew up in Indiana but had been to Barren County many, many times. We connected last year when I learned of the passing of his mother. I called his cell phone this week in hopes of speaking with his wife, Alice, to see how she was doing (I assume the cell phone still had service). After ringing several times, Greg's voicemail greeting began. While I knew he passed away almost two months ago, I still was moved by the sound of his voice. I began to think about not only how much we had communicated, the plans we had this year to get together, but also the "briefness" of life!

It is not news to anyone that we all have a limited number of sunsets. Hebrews 9:27 says, "And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgement..." James tells us in chapter four, verses 13-14, "Come now, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit'; whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away."

The information we have should ensure we have a "transformation of dedication" to Jesus Christ.

Realizing no one knows how much time each has should get our attention and focus on what's most important. What's most important is the hope we have in Jesus Christ. When we are obedient and submit our life to Christ, we can be sure and confident of our eternal home (Hebrews 6:19). We can rest upon the promises of God (Hebrews 6:13-18), and know our hope is laid up in Heaven (Colossians 1:5, 27).

Losing someone (especially unexpectedly) should fuel us to know Christ and share Him with others. May we do both while we have time.



## GOD' WILL FOR US...IN EVERYTHING GIVE THANKS

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

**INTRODUCTION...** In our previous lesson, we learned that we are to **rejoice always** and **pray without ceasing** and if we return to the 1Thessalonians 5:16-18 text, we learn that this is also God' will for us. We are to give thanks in everything, give thanks to all circumstances. This morning we will look at why it is necessary to continually give thanks.

#### I. The Need to Give Thanks

- (A) Ingratitude Displeases God
  - (1) 2 Timothy 3:1-5, Romans 1:18-21
- (B) We Should Have the Attitude of Gratitude
  - (1) Col 1:12-14, 2:7
  - (2) Col 3:12-15, 4:2
  - (3) 1 Timothy 2:1
- (C) Thankfulness Is Always Key
  - (1) Phil 4:6-7
  - (2) 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

### II. How to Be Thankful in Everything

- (A) All Things Work for Good
  - (1) Romans 8:28, 1 John 5:3
  - (2) 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14, Romans 5:3-5
  - (3) Matthew 5:10-12, James 1:2-3
- (B) We Should Express Thanks in Every Prayer
  - (1) Phil 4:6, Daniel 6:10-11

**CONCLUSION.** There is a saying out there that goes like this: "When a person prays without giving thanks, they have clipped the wings of prayer, so that it cannot rise." I believe that all of us desire to get the full benefit of prayer in our lives and the ability to rejoice always. If that's true, we must take the time to thank God in everything **for** everything. Why? So that God can use it for our good. If we succeed at this, we will not only do what is God' will for us, but will become "more than conquerors" (Rom 8:35-39) through the love of God and the love of Christ.

- Conscience is what hurts when all your other parts feel so good!!!
- Ask not for a lighter burden, but for broader shoulders.
- Happiness is an inside job. Don't assign anyone else that much power of your life.
